**Local Language**

Any full-time employee shall be entitled to illness-in-the-line-of-duty leave (maximum 12 days per calendar year) when he/she has to be absent from duties because of personal injury received in the discharge of duty. Such personal injury must be reported promptly to the employee's immediate supervisor and proper injury report forms must be completed. Personnel who are being paid by Worker's Compensation because of an on-the-job injury are not authorized to use sick leave or annual leave to cover such absence.
