Local Language

Any student enrolled at Northwest Florida State College who is under the age of 18, non-military, and has not received a high school diploma, an equivalency or special diploma, or a certificate of high school attendance is subject to having his/her vehicle operator's license suspended unless the student is in compliance with provision of FS FS 322.091.

Secondary students enrolled at NWFSC during the fall and spring semesters who are under the dual credit program are subject to provisions of FS 322.091. Class attendance of such students shall be monitored by the Dean of Student Services and provisions of the rule applied as required. Dual credit students under the age of 18 who have five consecutive unexcused absences will be withdrawn from enrollment at the College and reported to their respective superintendent for appropriate action.

Other non-military students under age 18 enrolled in credit and noncredit courses, including adult basic education, are also subject to provisions of FS 322.091 and attendance of such students will be monitored by the Dean of Student Services and provisions of the rule implemented as required.
