ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Completion of an Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree from a regionally accredited college or university or at least 60 semester hours of postsecondary education from a regionally accredited college or university.
2. Completion of all General Education Requirements and lower-division state-mandated common prerequisites, including the three Common Education prerequisites: EDF 1005, EDF 2085 and EME 2040.

Middle Grades General Science and Middle Grades Mathematics programs have specific prerequisite requirements which are subject to change by legislative mandate. Please contact an advisor for current requirements.

A minimum grade of "C" is required in each of these prerequisite courses.

3. A minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale for the general education component of undergraduate studies or completion of the requirements for a baccalaureate degree with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale from any college or university accredited by a regional accrediting association or otherwise approved pursuant to State Board of Education rule.
4. Passing scores on the General Knowledge Test of the Florida Teacher Certification Examination (FTCE). ***Students are not admitted to the Teacher Education program until this requirement is met.***
5. Completion of the standard Florida foreign language upper division admission requirement. (If, at the time of admission, the student has not completed two years of the same foreign language in high school or eight credits in college, the student will need to complete eight credits of foreign language before completing the program.)
6. Agreement to submit to fingerprinting and background checks by both the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). Note: The outcome of the background check may impact the student's eligibility to meet selected program requirements, including completion of the teaching internship and various field experiences.

STEPS TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION:

- Complete a NWFSC Admission & Residency Form (or NWFSC Readmission & Residency Form if you previously attended NWFSC and more than 12 months has passed since your last date of attendance) and meet all requirements for admission to the College as a degree-seeking student.
- Complete a NWFSC BS in Education Baccalaureate Supplemental Application Form and meet all requirements for admission to the BS in Education Program.
- Submit official high school and college transcripts from all previously attended colleges and universities to include official score reports from CLEP, DANTES, AP, and IB.
- Complete an Orientation/Advising Session.
