



Health Services Management

General Information

Moving beyond a certificate or diploma, an Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) in Health Services Management allows the student who already possesses a diploma or certification in a medical-technical field to have a broadened scope on which to build a career in customer service, office management, certificate program educator, or medical supply sales. Students without prior medical training find the degree provides them with opportunities in office management and medical customer service.

The program is 62-credits in length and can be completed in four to five semesters of full-time study. Students should have a foundation in a medical technical field such as dental assisting, emergency medical technician, surgical technology, or licensed practical nursing (LPN) prior to entering the program.

What is the job outlook and salary range?

The salary range is dependent upon the practice area: customer service, office management or medical supply sales.

The annual salary may range from \$22,500 to \$32,000 (Florida Agency for Workforce Innovation Labor Market Statistics).

Coursework for the Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree in Health Services Management is available at all seven Northwest Florida State College locations and through eCampus/Distance Learning options.

What is the cost of the program?

Northwest Florida State College fees are among the lowest in Florida of any state college or university. A special in-state fee is available at NWFSC for Alabama residents.
