FALL 2015 ADMISSION CHECKLIST

To be eligible for admission to the Fall 2015 NWFSC Nursing Program, you must:

- Be admitted to Northwest Florida State College. Visit the college website at <http://www.nwfsc.edu/Students/Enrollment/Admissions/index.cfm> for details.
- Complete Nursing Application and submit to the Associate Degree Nursing office by July 13, 2015.
- Be enrolled in the following college-level courses (if you have not already completed them while dual-enrolled) for the Summer 2015 term. You must successfully complete these courses (grade of “C” or higher) to be eligible for the program:
 - Anatomy & Physiology I (BSC1085C)
 - English Composition I (ENC1101)
 - College Algebra (MAC1105) **or** Statistics (STA2023)
- Obtain PERT scores (or SAT/ACT scores) and all required prep courses completed (if needed) by August 1, 2015.
- Submit official **high school** transcript to NWFSC admissions office by August 1, 2015. If you are currently taking classes at NWFSC, your transcripts will already be on file.
- Submit **official** transcripts from all other postsecondary institutions attended including CLEP, AP, IB transcripts to NWFSC admissions office by August 13, 2015. If you are currently taking classes at NWFSC, your transcripts will already be on file.
- Have a cumulative college Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 or higher on a 4.00 scale.
- Take your first attempt of the Nursing Admission Assessment Exam (HESI A²) by July 13, 2015 and the second attempt (optional) by August 3, 2015. You must score 75% or higher on each component of the exam by your second attempt.
