

**NORTHWEST FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE  
ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (ASN) SELECTION PROCESS  
NEW HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES - Fall 2015**

**Pool of Eligible Applicants**

- Admitted to NWFSC
- Submit application to the Associate Degree Nursing department by July 13, 2015
- Completed current online NWFSC Nursing Program Information Session & submitted post-test/confirmation form by July 20, 2015
- Nursing Admission Assessment Exam – minimum score of 75% on each component\*\*
- PERT scores (or SAT/ACT scores) & all required prep courses completed (if needed) completed by August 1, 2015
- ALL transcripts - high school and any college (other dual-enrolled, IB credits, etc.) received by August 13, 2015
- Cumulative college Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 or higher on a 4.00 scale\*



All eligible applicants accepted unless the number exceeds the available slots, in which case the weighted point system will be used to select students.

**Weighted Point System**

Item	Points
a. Anatomy and Physiology I with a grade of "C" or higher (taken Summer 2015 or when dual-enrolled)	10
Complete the course as stipulated with a grade of "B" or higher to earn additional points	15 <i>(added to points from item a)</i>
b. College Algebra (or higher) or college level Statistics with a grade of "C" or higher (taken Summer 2015 or when dual-enrolled)	5
Complete one of these courses with a grade of "B" or higher to earn additional points	10 <i>(added to points from item b)</i>
c. College level English Composition with a grade of "C" or higher (taken Summer 2015 or when dual-enrolled)	5
Complete the course with a grade of "B" or higher to earn additional points	10 <i>(added to points from item c)</i>
d. Current Okaloosa or Walton County Residency by <u>July 13, 2015</u> (subject to additional documentation upon request)	5
e. Unweighted GPA of 3.00 or higher on a scale of 4.00 for all college coursework *	5
f. Unweighted GPA of 3.50 or higher on a scale of 4.00 for all college coursework*	10 <i>(added to points from item e)</i>
g. Nursing Admission Assessment Exam scores of 80% or higher on each component**	15
h. Nursing Admission Assessment Exam scores of 90% or higher on each component**	10 <i>(added to points from item g)</i>
Maximum Points Available	100

The applicants with the highest point totals are admitted first. If there is a tie among point totals prior to reaching program capacity, the following formula will be used to determine selection: (cumulative score on Admission Assessment Exam) + (GPA as in items e & f above X 25) = points

\*GPA is determined based upon policies published in the current NWFSC Catalog and Student Handbook and as determined by the College Registrar. College prep, developmental, and upper division courses will not be included in determining GPA.
