FALL 2016 ADMISSION CHECKLIST

To be eligible for admission to the Fall 2016 NWFSC Nursing Program, you must:

- Be admitted to Northwest Florida State College. Visit the college website at <http://www.nwfsc.edu/Students/Enrollment/Admissions/index.cfm> for details.
- Complete Nursing Application and submit to the Associate Degree Nursing office by July 15, 2016.
- Be enrolled in the following college-level courses (if you have not already completed them while dual-enrolled) for the Summer 2016 term. You must successfully complete these courses (grade of “C” or higher) to be eligible for the program by Fall 2016.
 - Anatomy & Physiology I (BSC1085C)
 - English Composition I (ENC1101)
 - College Algebra (MAC1105) **or** Statistics (STA2023)
- Obtain PERT scores (or SAT/ACT scores) and all required prep courses completed (if needed) by August 1, 2016.
- Submit official **high school** transcript to NWFSC admissions office by August 1, 2016. If you are currently taking classes at NWFSC, your transcripts will already be on file.
- Submit **official** transcripts from all other postsecondary institutions attended including CLEP, AP, IB transcripts to NWFSC admissions office by August 1, 2016. If you are currently taking classes at NWFSC, your transcripts will already be on file.
- Have a cumulative college Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 or higher on a 4.00 scale. For students who have not earned graded non-developmental college hours at a regionally accredited institution, the high school GPA at the time of graduation, or GED scores will be considered.
- You must score 75% or higher on each component of the of the Nursing Admission Assessment Exam (HESI A²) exam after two attempts by August 1, 2016. More information about the test is available at http://www.nwfsc.edu/Academics/Departments/HealthSciences/Nursing/rn/hesi_exam_information.cfm.
