FALL 2016 ADMISSION CHECKLIST

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION TO THE FALL 2016 NWFSC LPN TO RN PROGRAM, YOU MUST:

- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Apply to NWFSC if you are a new student to the college, or reapply if you have not taken classes at NWF State College within the last two semesters.
- Complete Nursing Online Application by the published deadline
- Complete the current online NWFSC Nursing Program Information Session and post-test by the published deadline. **NOTE: You will not be eligible for the nursing program if you do not complete the information session post-test by the published deadline.**
- Score 75% or higher on each component of the Nursing Admission Assessment Exam (HESI A²) by the published deadline. Each component must be passed with a 75% or higher to be an eligible candidate.
- You must have an active, unencumbered Florida Practical Nursing (PN) license or be eligible for Florida PN license. Applicants who are currently enrolled in a PN program may apply, and if accepted, be granted provisional admission provided they obtain licensure no later than the first day of Fall 2016 classes.
- Obtain PERT scores (or SAT/ACT scores) and complete all required college prep courses (if needed) by published deadline.
- Submit official **high school** transcript or GED diploma or score report to NWFSC admissions office by published deadline. If you are currently taking classes at NWF State College, your transcripts will already be on file.
- Submit **official** transcripts from all other postsecondary institutions attended including CLEP, AP, IB transcripts to NWFSC admissions office by the published deadline. If you are currently taking classes at NWFSC, your transcripts will already be on file.
- Complete the following courses before Fall 2016:
 - Human Anatomy & Physiology I (taken within 5 years of admission to the nursing program)
 - Human Anatomy & Physiology II (taken within 5 years of admission to the nursing program)
 - English Composition I
 - Human Nutrition
