ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE DEGREE – NURSING (LPN-RN)
FALL 2012 ADMISSION CHECKLIST

To be eligible for admission to the NWFSC Nursing Program, you must have:

___ an active, unencumbered Florida LPN license or eligible for Florida licensure by endorsement/examination.

Note: Students enrolled in a practical nursing program may apply, and, if selected, may be granted provisional admission but must provide a certificate of completion from their practical nursing program along with a copy of their Florida LPN license no later than the first day of Fall 2011 classes. Candidates who fail to meet licensure requirements by the deadline may apply for subsequent LPN Transition programs; however, they are not guaranteed admission.

___ completed the following prerequisite courses by the end of the Fall 2011 semester:

- *Anatomy & Physiology I with a grade of "C" or higher within the last five years (Fall 2007 or later)*
- *Anatomy & Physiology II with a grade of "C" or higher within the last five years (Fall 2007 or later)*
- *Human Growth & Development with a grade of "C" or higher*
- *Nutrition with a grade of "C" or higher*
- *Sociology with a grade of "C" or higher*

___ a cumulative college Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher.

The following requirements must be met by January 31, 2012 to be considered for admission to the Nursing Program:

- Be admitted to Northwest Florida State College. Visit the college website at www.nwfsc.edu/admissions for details.
- If you have previously attended NWFSC, and have not taken classes within one (1) year of application, you must submit readmission & residency forms. The forms can be found at www.nwfsc.edu/owcc_pdf_forms/ReadmissionForm.pdf.
- Submit *official* high school transcript or GED diploma or score report to NWFSC admissions office.
- Submit *official* transcripts from all other postsecondary institutions attended including CLEP, AP, IB transcripts to NWFSC admissions office.
- Complete FCPT (Florida College Placement Test), if required, with scores sufficient for placement into college level courses in Reading, English and Math OR complete required college preparatory courses.
- Score 75% or higher on each component of the Nursing Admission Assessment Exam. More information about taking the test is available at <http://www.nwfsc.edu/nursing/rn/exam.cfm>.
- Submit NWFSC Nursing & Allied Health online application September 1 - December 15, 2011. Application instructions can be found at www.nwfsc.edu/nursing.

Important notes:

- ❖ Official transcripts for all classes taken during the Fall 2011 semester MUST be submitted to the NWFSC registrar no later than January 31, 2012.
- ❖ In order to have a competitive application for the nursing program, we recommend you attend a NWFSC Nursing Program Information Session during current year of application.
