FALL 2015 ADMISSION CHECKLIST

To be eligible for admission to the Fall 2015 NWFSC Nursing Program, you must:

- Complete the current online NWFSC Nursing Program Information Session. You are **required** to submit the post-test/confirmation form by December 15, 2014. For details about completing the information session, visit www.nwfsc.edu/Academics/Departments/HealthSciences/Nursing/rn/infosessions.cfm. **NOTE: Your application will not be considered if you have not submitted the information post-test by the deadline.**
- Complete Nursing Online Application by December 15, 2014. The application will be available online September 1, 2014. Visit www.nwfsc.edu/Academics/Departments/HealthSciences/Nursing/rn/apply.cfm for application instructions.
- Score 75% or higher on each component of the Nursing Admission Assessment Exam (HESI A²). You must take the first attempt no later than **December 15, 2014**. You may choose to repeat the exam **ONE** time; the second attempt must be taken no later than January 30, 2015.
- If you have previously attended NWFSC, and have not taken classes within one (1) year of application, you must reapply for admission to the college. To reapply for admission, go to www.nwfsc.edu/Students/Enrollment/Admissions/, click on Apply Online button in center of page, then answer “No” to “If this is your first time applying to NWFSC”.
- Obtain PERT scores (or SAT/ACT scores) and complete all required prep courses (if needed)
- Have a cumulative college Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 or higher on a 4.00 scale
- Submit official **high school** transcript or official GED diploma or score report to NWFSC admissions office by January 30, 2015. If you are currently taking classes at NWFSC, your transcripts will already be on file.
- Submit **official** transcripts from all other postsecondary institutions attended including CLEP, AP, IB transcripts to NWFSC admissions office by January 30, 2015. If you are currently taking classes at NWFSC, your transcripts will already be on file.
