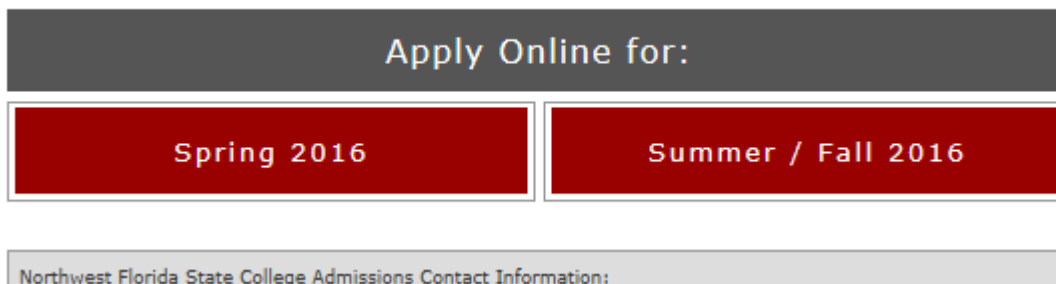


To apply for the Fall 2016 Nursing (RN) or (LPN to RN) Programs at NWFSC:

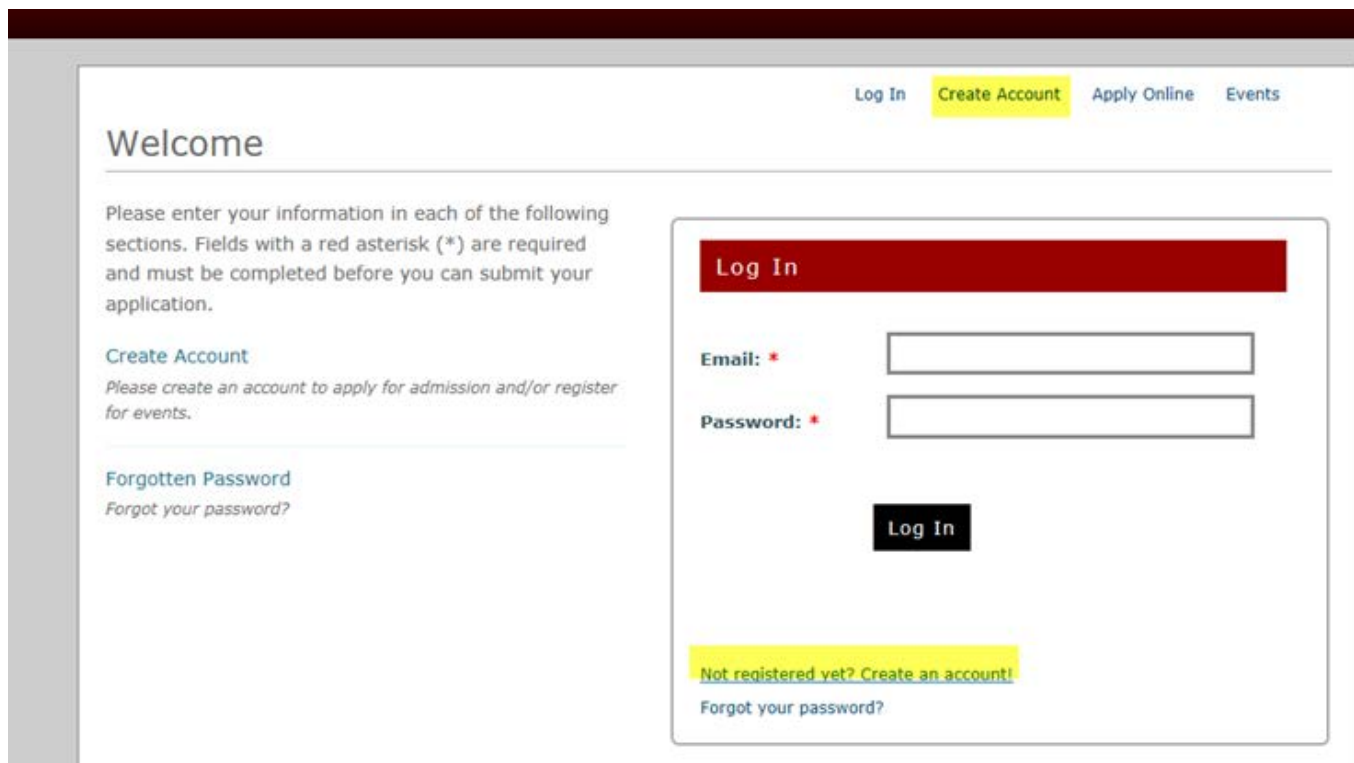
1. Go to [www.nwfsc.edu](http://www.nwfsc.edu)
