Fall 2017 Application Deadlines have not been finalized. Please visit the nursing website often for the most up-to-date information about the application process.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION TO THE FALL 2017 NWF State College NURSING PROGRAM, YOU MUST:

- Apply to NWF State College if you are a new student, or reapply if you have not taken classes within the last two semesters.
- Complete the current online NWF State College Nursing Program Information Session by the published deadline. **NOTE: You will not be eligible to apply if you do not complete the information session.**
- Complete Nursing Online Application by the published deadline.
- Score 75% or higher on each component of the Nursing Admission Assessment Exam (HESI A²) by the published deadline.
- Obtain PERT scores (or SAT/ACT scores) and complete all required college prep courses (if needed) by published deadline.
- Submit official **high school** transcript or GED diploma or score report to NWFSC admissions office by published deadline. If you are currently taking classes at NWFSC, your transcripts will already be on file.
- Submit **official** transcripts from all other postsecondary institutions attended including CLEP, AP, IB transcripts to NWFSC admissions office by the published deadline. If you are currently taking classes at NWFSC, your transcripts will already be on file.
