FALL 2013 ADMISSION CHECKLIST

To be eligible for admission to the Fall 2013 NWFSC Nursing Program, you must have:

___ completed the following prerequisite courses by the end of the Fall 2012 semester:

- *Anatomy & Physiology I with a grade of “C” or higher within the last five years (Fall 2008 or later)*
- *Anatomy & Physiology II with a grade of “C” or higher within the last five years (Fall 2008 or later)*
- *Human Growth & Development with a grade of “C” or higher*
- *Sociology – not required, but recommended in order to have a competitive application.*

___ a cumulative college Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher.

The following requirements must be met by January 31, 2013 to be considered for admission to the Nursing Program:

- Be admitted to Northwest Florida State College. Visit the college website at www.nwfsc.edu/admissions for details.
- If you have previously attended NWFSC, and have not taken classes within one (1) year of application, you must submit readmission & residency forms. The forms can be found at www.nwfsc.edu/owcc_pdf_forms/ReadmissionForm.pdf.
- Submit *official* high school transcript or GED diploma or score report to NWFSC admissions office.
- Submit *official* transcripts from all other postsecondary institutions attended including CLEP, AP, IB transcripts to NWFSC admissions office.
- Complete college placement testing if required, with scores sufficient for placement into college level courses in Reading, English and Math OR complete required college preparatory courses.
- Score 75% or higher on each component of the Nursing Admission Assessment Exam (HESI A²). More information about the test is available at <http://www.nwfsc.edu/nursing/rn/exam.cfm>.
- Submit NWFSC Nursing & Allied Health online application September 1 - December 15, 2012. Application instructions can be found at www.nwfsc.edu/nursing beginning September 1st.

Important notes:

- ❖ **Official transcripts for all classes taken during the Fall 2012 semester MUST be submitted to the NWFSC Registrar/Admissions Office no later than January 31, 2013.**
- ❖ **In order to have a competitive application for the nursing program, we recommend you:**
 - **Complete SYG2000 Sociology with a grade of “C” or higher.**
