**FALL 2014 ADMISSION CHECKLIST**

**To be eligible for admission to the Fall 2014 NWFSC Nursing Program, you must:**

- Complete Nursing Online Application by December 15, 2013. The application will be available online September 1, 2013. Visit <http://www.nwfsc.edu/nursing/rn/apply.cfm> for application instructions.
- If you have previously attended NWFSC, and have not taken classes within one (1) year of application, you must submit readmission & residency forms. The forms can be found at [www.nwfsc.edu/owcc\\_pdf\\_forms/ReadmissionForm.pdf](http://www.nwfsc.edu/owcc_pdf_forms/ReadmissionForm.pdf).
- Obtain college placement test scores (or SAT/ACT scores) and all required prep courses completed (if needed)
- Have a cumulative college Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 or higher on a 4.00 scale
- Submit official **high school** transcript or GED diploma or score report to NWFSC admissions office by January 31, 2014. If you are currently taking classes at NWFSC, your transcripts will already be on file.
- Submit **official** transcripts from all other postsecondary institutions attended including CLEP, AP, IB transcripts to NWFSC admissions office by January 14, 2014. If you are currently taking classes at NWFSC, your transcripts will already be on file.
- Complete current online NWFSC Nursing Program Information Session and submit post-test/confirmation form by December 15, 2013. For information about completing the information session, visit [www.nwfsc.edu/nursing/rn/infosessions.cfm](http://www.nwfsc.edu/nursing/rn/infosessions.cfm).
- Score 75% or higher on each component of the Nursing Admission Assessment Exam (HESI A<sup>2</sup>). More information about the test is available at <http://www.nwfsc.edu/nursing/rn/exam.cfm>.
