

**NORTHWEST FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE
ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (ASN) ADMISSION PROCESS**

Pool of Eligible Applicants

- Admitted to NWFSC
- Completed Nursing Online Application (Application period: September 1, 2012 through December 15, 2012)
- All final paperwork must be received by January 31, 2013:
 - College placement testing scores and all required prep courses completed
 - Cumulative college Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 or higher on a 4.00 scale*
 - College level Anatomy & Physiology I *and* II with a grade of “C” or higher within five years of starting Nursing core courses (A&P I *and* II taken Fall 2008 through Fall 2012)
 - College level Human Growth and Development with a grade of “C” or higher
 - Nursing Admission Assessment Exam – minimum score of 75% on each component**



All eligible applicants accepted unless the number exceeds the available slots, in which case the weighted point system will be used to select students.

Weighted Point System

Item	Points
a. College level Sociology with a grade of “C” or higher	10
b. Anatomy and Physiology I with a grade of “B” or higher within five years of starting Nursing core courses (Fall 2008 – Fall 2012)	15
c. Anatomy and Physiology II with a grade of “B” or higher within five years of starting Nursing core courses (Fall 2008 – Fall 2012)	15
d. Current Okaloosa or Walton County Residency by <u>January 31, 2013</u> (<i>subject to additional documentation upon request</i>)	5
e. Complete the online NWFSC Nursing Program Information Session during current application cycle by <u>December 15, 2012</u>	5
f. Unweighted GPA of 3.00 or higher on a scale of 4.00 for all college coursework completed within the last five years (Fall 2008 – Fall 2012); if less than 12 credits in the last five years, the most recent 12 credit hours of college coursework will be used.*	15
g. Unweighted GPA of 3.50 or higher on a scale of 4.00 for all college coursework completed within the last five years (Fall 2008 – Fall 2012); if less than 12 credits in the last five years, the most recent 12 credit hours of college coursework will be used.*	10 (<i>added to points from item f.</i>)
h. Nursing Admission Assessment Exam scores of 80% or higher on each component**	15
i. Nursing Admission Assessment Exam scores of 90% or higher on each component**	10 (<i>added to points from item h.</i>)
Maximum Points Available	100

The applicants with the highest point totals are admitted first. If there is a tie among point totals prior to reaching program capacity, the following formula will be used to determine selection:
(cumulative score on Admission Assessment Exam) + (GPA as in items f & g above X 25) = points

*GPA and acceptance of transfer work is determined based upon policies published in the current NWFSC Catalog and Student Handbook and as determined by the College Registrar. College prep, developmental, and upper division courses will not be included in determining GPA.
