

**NORTHWEST FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE  
ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (ASN) ADMISSION PROCESS**

**Pool of Eligible Applicants**

- Admitted to NWFSC
- Completed Nursing Online Application (Application period: September 1, 2011 through **December 15, 2011**)
- All final paperwork must be received by **January 31, 2012**:
  - College placement testing scores and all required prep courses completed
  - Cumulative college Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 or higher on a 4.00 scale\*
  - College level Anatomy & Physiology I *and* II with a grade of “C” or higher within five years of starting Nursing core courses (A&P I *and* II taken Fall 2007 through Fall 2011)
  - College level Human Growth and Development with a grade of “C” or higher
  - Nursing Admission Assessment Exam – minimum score of 75% on each component\*\*



All eligible applicants accepted unless the number exceeds the available slots, in which case the weighted point system will be used to select students.

**Weighted Point System**

Item	Points
a. College level Sociology with a grade of “C” or higher	10
b. Anatomy and Physiology I with a grade of “B” or higher within five years of starting Nursing core courses (Fall 2007 – Fall 2011)	15
c. Anatomy and Physiology II with a grade of “B” or higher within five years of starting Nursing core courses (Fall 2007 – Fall 2011)	15
d. Current Okaloosa or Walton County Residency by <b>January 31, 2012</b> <i>(subject to additional documentation upon request)</i>	5
e. Complete the online NWFSC Nursing Program Information Session during current application cycle by <b>December 15, 2011</b>	5
f. Unweighted GPA of 3.00 or higher on a scale of 4.00 for all college coursework completed within the last five years (Fall 2007 – Fall 2011); if less than 12 credits in the last five years, the most recent 12 credit hours of college coursework will be used.*	15
g. Unweighted GPA of 3.50 or higher on a scale of 4.00 for all college coursework completed within the last five years (Fall 2007 – Fall 2011); if less than 12 credits in the last five years, the most recent 12 credit hours of college coursework will be used.*	10 <i>(added to points from item f.)</i>
h. Nursing Admission Assessment Exam scores of 80% or higher on each component**	15
i. Nursing Admission Assessment Exam scores of 90% or higher on each component**	10 <i>(added to points from item h.)</i>
Maximum Points Available	100

The applicants with the highest point totals are admitted first. If there is a tie among point totals prior to reaching program capacity, the following formula will be used to determine selection:  
 $(\text{cumulative score on Admission Assessment Exam}) + (\text{GPA as in items f \& g above} \times 25) = \text{points}$

\*GPA and acceptance of transfer work is determined based upon policies published in the current **NWFSC Catalog and Student Handbook** and as determined by the College Registrar. College prep, developmental, and upper division courses will not be included in determining GPA.
