

**NORTHWEST FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE
RADIOGRAPHY PROGRAM SELECTION PROCESS – SUMMER 2017**

Pool of Eligible Applicants

- Admitted to NWF State College
- Completed Radiography Online Application (Application period: January 3, 2017 through March 1, 2017)
- Completed current online NWFSC Radiography Program Information Session & submitted post-test/confirmation form by March 1, 2017
- HESI Admission Assessment Exam 1st attempt (if repeat desired) by January 27, 2017 – minimum score of 70%** on each component *** (may repeat; 2nd attempt deadline is March 1, 2017)
- All final paperwork must be received by March 1, 2017:
 - College placement testing scores and all prep courses completed
 - ALL transcripts (high school, other college/university)
 - Cumulative college Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 or higher on a 4.00 scale*The GPA is cumulative. For students who have not earned graded non-developmental college hours at a regionally accredited institution, the high school GPA at the time of graduation or GED scores will be considered

All eligible applicants accepted unless the number exceeds the available slots, in which case the weighted point system will be used to select students.

Weighted Point System

a. Current Okaloosa or Walton County Residency by <u>March 1, 2017</u> (subject to additional documentation upon request)	/5
b. Attended NWFSC Radiography Program Information Session	/10
HESI A2 Points	Max 25 points per section
c. Reading Comprehension _____% (your score) – 70%=	/25
d. Grammar _____% (your score) – 70% =	/25
e. Vocabulary _____% (your score) – 70% =	/25
f. Math _____% (your score) – 70% =	/25
g. Anatomy and Physiology _____% (your score) – 70% =	/25
h. A current Health Certification e.g. CNA, CMA, ECA, EMT, Pharmacy Tech., etc.	/10
Total score	Highest possible score 150 / 150

The applicants with the highest point totals are admitted first. If there is a tie among point totals prior to reaching program capacity, the following formula will be used to determine selection:
(Cumulative score on Admission Assessment Exam) + (GPA X 25) = points

*GPA and acceptance of transfer work is determined based on policies published in the current NWFSC Catalog and Student Handbook and as determined by the College Registrar. College prep, developmental, and upper division courses will not be included in determining GPA.

** Combined score of 70% may be considered for alternates – (pending approval)
