FALL 2015 ADMISSION CHECKLIST

To be eligible for admission to the NWFSC Radiography Program, you must have:

___ completed the following prerequisite courses by the end of the Fall 2014 semester:

- *Anatomy & Physiology I and Anatomy & Physiology II with a grade of “C” or higher within the last five years**
- *-or- BSC 2020C Human structure and Function with a grade of “C” or higher within the last five years*
- *College level Algebra or comparable higher level math with a grade of “C” or higher*

___ cumulative college Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher.

The following requirements must be met by January 31, 2015 to be considered for admission to the Radiography Program:

- ___ Be admitted to Northwest Florida State College. Visit the college website at www.nwfsc.edu/admissions for details.
- ___ If you have previously attended NWFSC, and have not taken classes within one (1) year of application, you must submit readmission & residency forms. The forms can be found at www.nwfsc.edu/owcc_pdf_forms/ReadmissionForm.pdf.
- ___ Submit *official* high school transcript or GED diploma or score report to NWFSC admissions office.
- ___ Submit *official* transcripts from all other postsecondary institutions attended to NWFSC admissions office.
- ___ Complete college placement testing if required, with scores sufficient for placement into college level courses in Reading, English and Math OR complete required college preparatory courses.
- ___ Meet the minimum score requirement of the Radiography Admission Assessment Exam (HESI) -see notes below.
- ___ Submit NWFSC Radiography & Allied Health online application September 1 - December 15, 2014. Application instructions can be found at www.nwfsc.edu/radiography beginning September 1st.

Important notes:

- ❖ ___ Official transcripts for all classes taken during the Fall 2014 semester MUST be submitted to the NWFSC registrar no later than January 31, 2014.
- ❖ ___ **You may only take the HESI twice during an application period. If you take the HESI more than twice, only the first two attempts will count toward the application process**
