Fine and Performing Arts Scholarship Application Guide

Application Process

The application process is complete when the following items are on file in the Fine and Performing Arts Division office, the Mattie Kelly Arts Center, NWFSC, Niceville campus:

1. **Completed scholarship application form.**
2. **Verification of applicant's cumulative GPA from the high school transcript.**
3. **Letters of recommendation.**

One letter is required from a high school dance line sponsor or private dance instructor and one letter from the guidance counselor. "Letter of Recommendation" forms are attached to facilitate this process.

4. **Photograph of applicant.** (Preferably wallet sized.)

This is NOT an optional item! Please attach to your scholarship application with a paper clip, not a staple. Please print your name on the bottom back of the photo.

5. **Verification of your participation in the 2-day audition.**

Evaluation Schedule

Failure to submit your paperwork by the dates listed below may result in a loss of ability to consider you for scholarship awards.

1. **Application Deadline:** Applications should be in received in the Fine Arts Division Office by **Apr. 26, 2010.**
2. A **2-day audition** will take place on **May 3 & 4, 2010**, in **Room J125 (Dance Studio)**. The schedule for both Monday and Tuesday May 3rd and 4th is 3:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. ****If you are unable to attend the audition after submitting an application please notify Joe Taylor at 729-6036. Leave a message on phone mail if necessary.***
