Fine and Performing Arts Scholarship Application Guide

Application Process

The application process is complete when the following items are on file in the Humanities, Fine and Performing Arts Division Office, J-112, The Arts Center, Northwest Florida State College, Niceville campus:

1. **Completed, TYPED scholarship application form.**
2. **Verification of applicant's cumulative GPA (Guidance Counselor's form).**
3. **Letters of recommendation.** One letter is required from a high school choral director or private instructor and one letter from the guidance counselor or principal. "Letter of Recommendation" forms are attached to facilitate this process.
4. **Photograph of applicant.** (Preferably wallet sized.) ***This is NOT an optional item!*** Please attach to your scholarship application with a paperclip; do not use staples, tape, or glue. Please print your name on the bottom back edge of the photo.
5. **Schedule your audition.** Please call Mary Lou Baker in the Fine and Performing Arts Division office at 729-5382 to schedule your audition. ***You must provide your own accompaniment - CD, tape, or piano.***

Evaluation Schedule

Failure to submit your paperwork by the dates listed below may result in your work not being considered for scholarship awards.

Application Deadline: April 23 rd. *All application materials must be received in the Fine Arts Division office by this date.*

Audition Dates: May 7th and May 8th. Please choose which date works best for you. If you are unable to keep your audition appointment, it is imperative that you contact Mary Lou Baker at 729-5382.
