The Presidential Search Advisory Committee has established a deadline of December 4, 2009 to receive completed applications that are assured consideration by the Committee. Applications received after the deadline are not guaranteed consideration. However, the Committee reserves the right to review applications until the appointment is made. Completed applications consist of a current resume; a letter requesting to be considered for the position that also addresses the presidential qualifications and attributes; and a list of five references knowledgeable of the applicant's leadership qualities and professional achievements. Included in the reference list should be e-mail addresses and daytime telephone numbers.

Nominations, expressions of interest and completed applications should be submitted electronically (MS Word or Adobe PDF) to NWFSC@academic-search.com.
