Northwest Florida State College Concurrent Enrollment program provides the opportunity for qualified high school and middle school students (who are at least 13 years of age by August 1 of the academic year in which they plan to enroll) from Okaloosa and Walton Counties, who meet the specified eligibility criteria, to enroll in certain college courses while simultaneously enrolled in a public, private or home school. College credits earned through concurrent enrollment, unlike dual enrollment, do not apply to a students' high school diploma. Students concurrently enrolled pay all registration, laboratory and tuition fees; and are also responsible for purchasing all textbooks.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Students must:

- Be a middle school student (grades 9 or lower; and at least 13 years of age by the first day of class for the term in which they plan to enroll)
- Have a minimum unweighted 2.00 GPA.
- Have permission of principal (or home school provider), parent and the approval of the college.
- Enroll for audit** only, on a space available basis, contact the Dual Enrollment Office for further information at 729-5205.

**A student registering in a college-credit course on a "not-for-credit" basis will be enrolled in an audit status. Upon completion of the course, an "X" grade will be awarded with no impact on the student's GPA. Students auditing a class are not required to complete examinations but are expected to attend classes and participate in other activities and requirements on the same basis as students seeking credit.
- Enroll on a Space-Available-Basis, no earlier than the first day of classes.
- If a home-schooled student, a copy of your current signed and updated *Legal Compliance and Eligibility Form* (proof of enrollment in a home school program) on file with your school district must be submitted to NWFSC at time of enrollment.
