

Parking, Traffic & Shuttle Service

The western side and the center of the Niceville Campus will be under construction for approximately two more years. Traffic flow & parking on the Niceville campus will therefore continue to be impacted. The college's new Community Services Complex is anticipated to be completed by November 2010 & the college will begin work on the new Student Services building in Fall 2010.

To serve students and the public, new parking areas have been opened & an improved shuttle service has been added (service starts Aug. 16 to Bookstore stop only & Aug. 23 to all shuttle stops). New parking is available by the college softball & baseball fields & some additional parking has been re-opened to the west & south of Building "L" (spaces formerly closed due to construction). Additionally, all parking lots have been re-painted. Yellow lined spaces are for college faculty & staff only. White lined spaces are OPEN PARKING for students, faculty or staff. There are no longer specific lots designated exclusively for students or staff parking. More OPEN PARKING means more parking choices for all!

Additionally, the college is re-instating the shuttle service with improvements over the 2009 pilot project. New this year, shuttles will run back & forth between central campus locations & key parking lots (rather than circling campus) to assist students & staff with access to central campus locations. **Shuttles will operate every 5 to 10 minutes from 7:30 am to 2:30 pm between the designated lots & Buildings "K" and "E" to get you to your destination on time!**

BE GREEN, BE HAPPY - Use the Shuttle & New Parking Lots!

We encourage everyone to park as far away from the center of campus as possible. Get some exercise, or enjoy a ride on the environmentally friendly electric shuttles. The Arts Center complex lot on the eastern edge of campus or the new lots by the ball fields are good choices. Remember shuttles **will operate every 5 to 10 minutes from 7:30 am to 2:30 pm to Buildings "K" and "E" from the shuttle stops shown on the map.** Shuttles will run continuously prior to & through peak morning & afternoon class times, but only as needed – look for the electric shuttles & the primary shuttle stops (indicated on map with red stars). **IMPORTANT NOTE:** In 2009, shuttle service was discontinued because of low utilization. If you want the service to continue – use the shuttles – they're provided for you!

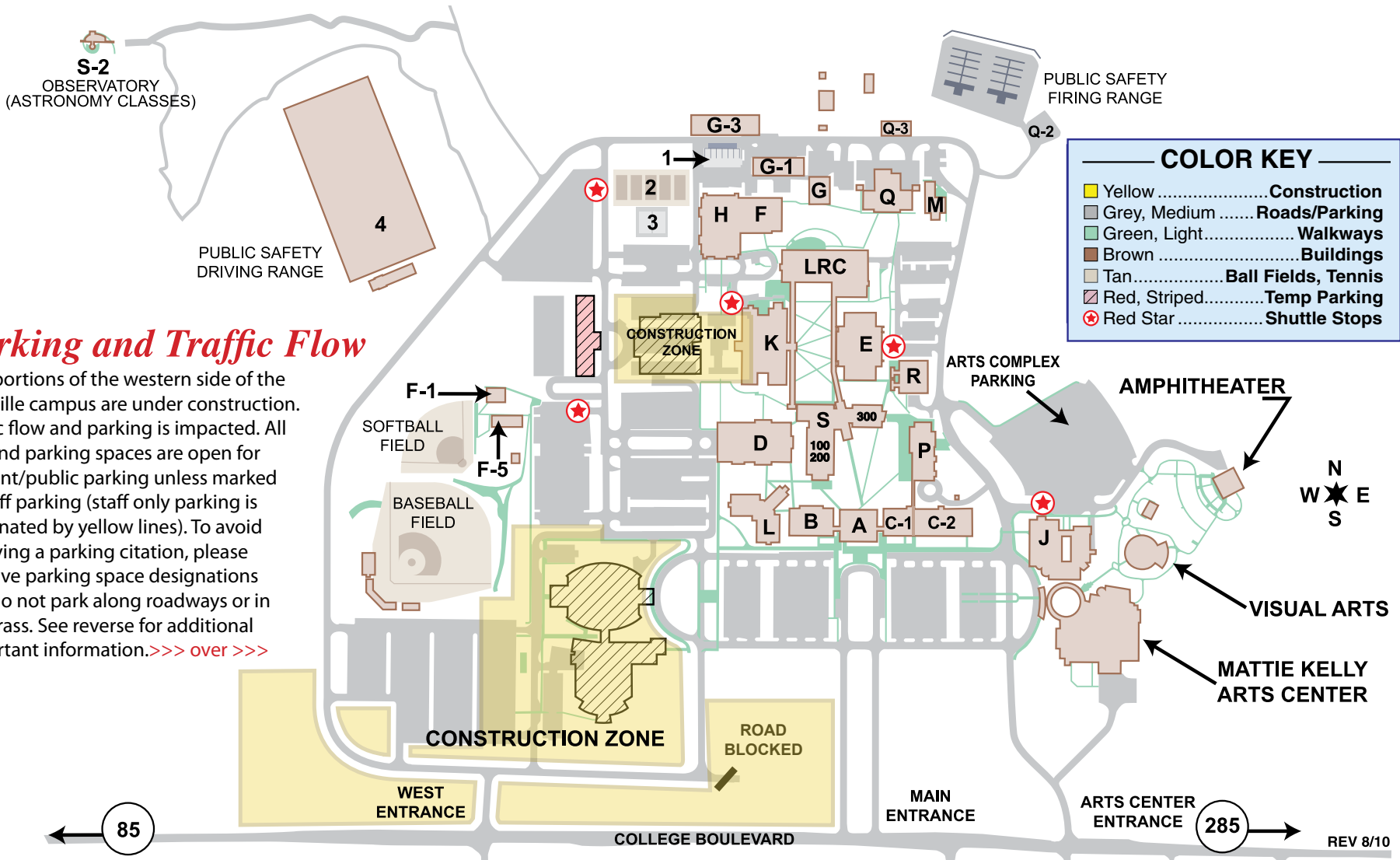


BE CAUTIOUS
