6A-14.077 Auxiliary Services and Enterprises and undesignated gifts.

Boards of trustees may operate or contract for auxiliary services and enterprises as defined in the accounting manual incorporated in Rule 6A-14.072, FAC, and may use funds generated from auxiliary operations and contracts and from undesignated gifts as provided herein.

(1) Auxiliary funds and undesignated gifts shall be spent according to rules of the board of trustees for the benefit of the college.

(a) The board of trustees may authorize a portion of such funds to be disbursed at the discretion of the president for: promotion and public relations and hospitality of business guests of the college. Hospitality expenditure shall not exceed one percent of the prior year total expenditures in the current unrestricted funds.

(b) The board of trustees may authorize other uses of such funds for the benefit of the college through its rules or by special action of the board.

(2) Funds used for purposes under subsection (1) of this rule shall be transferred to the appropriate fund of the

community college and included in the appropriate budget.

Local Language

Northwest Florida State College shall operate or contract for such auxiliary services, including vending services, as may be necessary and beneficial in furthering the educational program and services of the College.

1. Any funds accruing from auxiliary services shall be disbursed at the discretion of the President of the College for purposes which will directly benefit or be in the best interest of the College.
2. That portion of funds from auxiliary enterprises to be used for promotion and public relations shall be budgeted into the general current funds and used, upon authorization by the President, to provide for such expenditures.
3. Purchases from auxiliary funds, like all other purchases, shall be in accordance with the requirements of Florida Statutes and State Board Rules, and in accordance with the policies of the Board of Trustees.
