Local Language

1. Fees for College events shall be recommended by the President to the Board of Trustees in the annual budget for their approval.
2. The President will recommend to the Board for approval specific admission rates for special events, high-cost performances, Broadway Series, dinner theater banquets, and athletic events.
3. Full-time and part-time students and full-time and part-time employees, current trustees, former trustees, and retirees (plus one guest each) shall be admitted to all College produced events (other than "high cost" events or outside events for which an appropriate charge may be assessed) by contacting the theater box office. Current college ID cards will be required for students for identification.
4. Complimentary tickets may be authorized by the President for such persons, including members of the press, as he judges to be in the best interest of the educational programs and activities of the College.
5. The Arts Center Fiscal Manager shall maintain a list of persons who receive complimentary tickets.
6. Donations will not be taken at NWFSC performances unless specifically approved by the President on recommendation of the appropriate staff and/or sponsors of the events.
7. Occasions involving general public admission charges shall be held on Sunday only upon approval of the President.
8. Admission fees shall be reviewed periodically (no less than annually) by the Board of Trustees for their overall indication of the suitability of such admission charges.
