6A-14.058 Athletics.  
Athletics are authorized student activities, and, if conducted, shall be consistent with the basic purposes of the community college. Intercollegiate football shall not be conducted.

### **Local Language**

The Northwest Florida State College Recreation and Sports Activities Program shall consist of the following programs:

1. College-related recreational activities
2. Intramural activities
3. Extramural activities
4. Intercollegiate athletics

**College-related recreational activities** are those activities students choose to pursue during their discretionary time. These activities are limited to those sponsored by the College.

**Intramural activities** are competitive activities between teams or individuals within the College. These activities are open to college students, faculty, and staff.

**Extramural activities** are competitive activities between college-sponsored teams or individuals outside the college community such as military bases and sports clubs. Northwest Florida State College team members or individuals must be currently enrolled students for a minimum of six credit hours to participate or be college employees.

**Intercollegiate athletics** are team or individual competitions with other colleges. Participants must be full-time students who meet Florida Community College Association Activities eligibility requirements.

Scholarship support for intercollegiate athletics is authorized in accordance with Board of Trustee adopted policies and procedures, federal financial aid standards, and rules of the Florida Community College Activities Association and the National Junior College Athletic Association.
