Work Study: Steps to Apply

WORK STUDY (FWS) PROGRAM

STEPS TO APPLY:

1. Apply for admission to NWF State College.
2. Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the semester applicant plans on attending.

Example: complete the 2016-2017 FAFSA if you plan on attending the fall 2016, spring and/or summer 2017
3. Applicant's financial aid file must be completed/awarded before the FWS application can be processed.
4. Complete a current year NWF State College Work Study Application.
5. TO BE DEEMED ELIGIBLE THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA MUST BE MET:
 1. Applicant must register for a minimum of 6 compliant credit hours
 2. Applicant must meet the NWF State College standards of academic progress & maintain a 2.0 GPA.
 3. Applicant must have financial need based upon the estimated family contribution (EFC) number calculated by FAFSA and includes the cost of attendance, loans, scholarships and grants awarded.
6. Once eligible, the application will be sent to the Career Center in the Student Services Center.
7. Applicant may choose to visit the Career Services Center to create a resume.
8. Career Center staff will match up available job descriptions from college departments/offices with applicants' applications.
9. Supervisors will contact the Career Center for resumes and applications of qualified FWS applicants.
10. The supervisors will schedule interviews and select an applicant for the position in their office.
11. Student workers adhere to the work schedule agreed to by the supervisor and student.
12. Student workers submit their time sheet on the designated date and are paid on the last day of each month that they work.

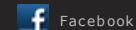
