Northwest Florida State College's Niceville campus is located on 264 acres between state roads 85 and 285. In addition to instructional programs for both college transfer and career and technical education and administrative facilities, the campus includes a state-of-the-art computer center, a child care center, a top-rated sports complex, technical labs, and a Criminal Justice Training Center. A 120,000 square foot center for the Fine and Performing Arts is located on the Niceville campus.

The Fort Walton Beach Campus operates in conjunction with the University of West Florida, sharing the facilities and same general location, to provide a 2 plus 2 higher education experience for the residents of Ft. Walton Beach and surrounding areas. The campus offers a variety of programs, courses required by specific programs predominately in UWF transfer areas, seminars/workshops, and community activities.

The Fort Walton Beach Campus offers educational support services similar to those at the main campus. These include computer and science laboratories, a library (maintained by the University of West Florida), audiovisual materials, a student lounge, and student services such as admissions/registration, counseling, and testing.

The NWFSC Chautauqua Center, located on 90 wooded acres along Highway 90 West in DeFuniak Springs, offers a range of college services and programs. Diversified college credit and non-credit programs including 2-year degrees, adult education/GED preparation, and personal enrichment courses are offered in day and evening classes. The center provides admissions/registration, financial aid information, placement testing and academic services. The center houses two computer labs, a career center, conferencing facilities, Academic Success tutors, a student lounge and gym.

The site is also the location for the local Headstart Child Care facilities and the Vocational Rehab office.

South Walton Center

The newest location of Northwest Florida State College, the NWFSC South Walton Center is located off of Highway 331 South and offers a series of college credit and non-credit personal enrichment offerings. The site is leased during the day in Fall and Spring by the Seacoast Collegiate High School. The South Walton Center is developed on 16 acres of a nearly 30 acre site owned by the college that is part of the county's government and education center. South Walton High School, the South Walton Library and the Walton County Government Center are located on adjacent parcels of the more than 110 acres originally acquired by the Walton County Commission from the state of Florida.

The facility consists of four buildings all under the same roofing structure with about 11,000 square feet of administrative and classroom space to serve the growing south Emerald Coast region.
