

NWFSC Student User Guide:

Course/Instructor Evaluations Surveys

Students will be given an opportunity to evaluate their instructors and courses through surveys utilizing the software CoursEval on RaiderNet. Surveys can be completed only during the survey window period. Students will receive an email notifying them surveys are available and will be prompted to log into RaiderNet to complete the available surveys. Surveys can be completed as soon as the student logs in or at another time.

The surveys are anonymous and instructors cannot view results until after grades are posted. Instructors are able to monitor the progress of open surveys but are unable to monitor individual student progress. Evaluations are not mandatory.

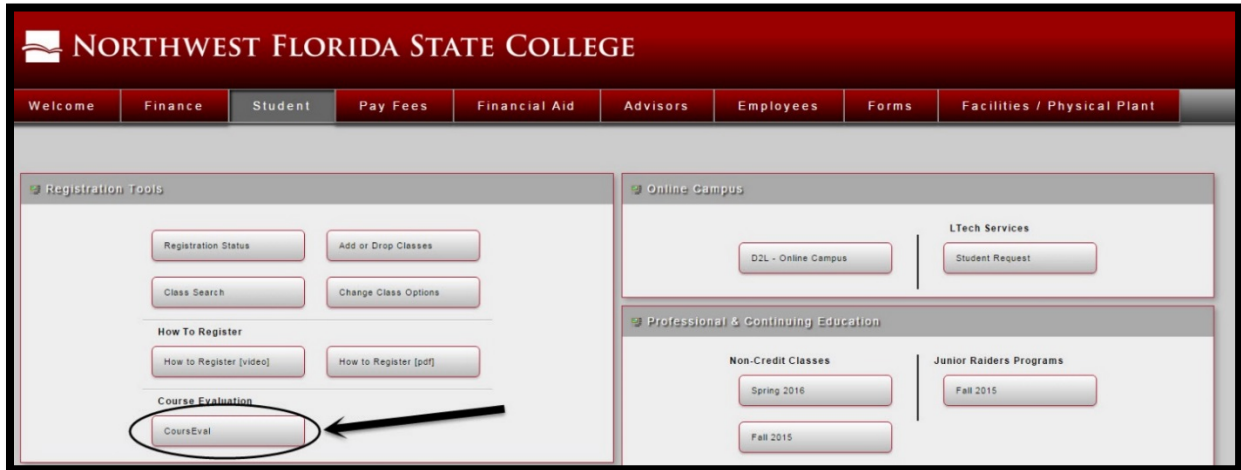
Students will receive an email asking them to log onto RaiderNet to complete their evaluation surveys.
