

Invitation To Bid 2018-2019-02 Invasive Plant Treatment on Coastal Dune Lakes in Walton County

Choctawhatchee Basin Alliance of Northwest Florida State College is seeking proposals from qualified firms to treat invasive and nuisance plant species in critical coastal dune lake habitat with low volume herbicide application in the spring of 2019 and re-treat of some of the lakes as needed in the fall. The main focal species of the treatment are torpedo grass, alligator weed, common reed, Chinese tallow trees, and other nuisance species as observed on the lakes. The dune lakes to be treated are Fuller Lake, Stallworth Lake, Allen Lake, Oyster Lake, Draper Lake, Big Redfish Lake, Little Redfish Lake, Alligator Lake, Western Lake, Eastern Lake and Camp Creek Lake. Contractors must be licensed and have past experience with aquatic invasive species treatment and removal, and preferably with working in critical habitat areas.
