The following program is specifically designed for Airmen with a <u>Community College of the Air Force</u> (CCAF) Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree. As an approved AU-ABC program, CCAF graduates are guaranteed that no more than 60 semester hours of additional credit will be required to complete the <u>BAS in Management and Supervision with an Emphasis in Military Science and Leadership</u> at Northwest Florida State College (NWFSC).

Students may also be eligible to earn the <u>AAS in Applied Management Degree</u> and the <u>Associate of Arts (AA) Degree</u> upon completion of the BAS Curriculum at NWFSC.
