

International applicants for admission to Northwest Florida State College (NWF) are required to submit test score reports from the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL). Score reports must be sent to the NWF Student Success Division directly from the testing agency; student copies are not accepted.

Minimum Score Requirement: 61 iBT

Applicants may request exemption from the language exam requirement if they meet and can provide documentation to support one of the following conditions:

- Native Speaker of English
- Earned a grade of C or better in a course equivalent to NWF's ENC 1101 or higher at a regionally accredited US institution
- Earned an associate's, bachelor's, or higher degree from a regionally accredited US institution
