THE RAIDERREP STUDENT AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

The RaiderRep Student Ambassador Program has been established at Northwest Florida State College to assist students who are interested in continuing their proven leadership skills while attending NWF. This scholarship is currently valued at \$1000.00 for 1 academic year at \$500 per Fall and Spring semester. Recipients must attend NWF and enroll in at least 6 credit hours. Additionally, students must complete 15 hours of RaiderRep Ambassador functions each semester and attend biweekly mandatory meetings. This could include; group tours, individual tours with prospective students, tours for new employees, attending events and hosting events. Students must participate in a minimum of three individual tours per semester. The RaiderRep Student Ambassador Program will serve as college ambassadors under the direction of the Outreach and Campus Experience Coordinator.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Candidates must apply for admission to NWF as a degree-seeking student.
- 2. Candidates must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average and prior leadership experience/involvement.
- 3. Students must enroll in at least 6 credit hours per semester.
- 4. Recipients will serve as a RaiderRep Student Ambassador for at least 1 academic year.

Application Requirements

The application process is complete when NWF Student Success Navigation verifies receipt of the following items:

- 1. Completed scholarship application form.
- 2. Completion of all NWF Admission requirements as a degree-seeking student.
- 3. Submit 2 letters of recommendation (one must be from a teacher).
- 4. Attach a photo of yourself on front page of application in top right hand corner.
- 5. Submit a 2-5 minute video introducing yourself and explaining why you would like to be a RaiderRep Student Ambassador. (optional)
- 6. Meet the Selection Committee for an interview if selected as a finalist.
