THE RAIDERREP STUDENT AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

of Northwest Florida State College

The RaiderRep Student Ambassador Program has been established at Northwest Florida State College to assist students who are interested in continuing their proven leadership skills while attending NWFSC. This scholarship is currently valued at \$1000.00 for 2 academic years at \$250 per Fall and Spring semesters. Recipients must attend NWFSC and enroll in at least 6 hours and apply for Federal Financial Aid. The scholarship may be renewable for a second year of study at NWFSC provided the recipient maintains the minimum grade point average and successfully completes the percentage of college coursework required by NWFSC's Federal Financial Aid Standards of Academic Progress as stated in the College Catalog. Additionally, students must complete 15 hours of RaiderRep Ambassador functions each semester. Students in the RaiderRep Student Ambassador Program will serve as college ambassadors under the direction of the Coordinator of Recruitment.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Candidates must apply for admission to NWFSC as a degree-seeking student.
- 2. Candidates must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average and prior leadership experience/involvement.
- 3. Students must enroll for at least 6 credit hours per semester
- 4. Recipients will serve as a RaiderRep Student Ambassador for at least 1 academic year, preferably 2

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The application process is complete when NWFSC Recruitment Office verifies receipt of the following items:

- 1 Completed scholarship application form
- 2. Completion of all NWFSC Admission requirements as a degree-seeking student.
- 3. Submit 2 letters of recommendation (one must be from a teacher)
- 4. Attach a color photo of yourself on front page of application in top right hand corner. (photo will not be returned)
- 5. Submit a 2-5 minute video introducing yourself and explaing why you would like to be a RaiderRep.
- 6 Meet the Selection Committee for an interview if selected as a finalist

All items must be received to be eligible for an interview.
