Pool of Eligible Applicants

- Completed NWF Admissions file
- Completed EMT Point System application
- Official Transcripts on file for all institutions previously attended
- Active, unencumbered Driver's license

All eligible applicants accepted unless the number exceeds the available slots, in which case the weighted point system will be used to select students.

Weighted Point System

Item	Points
a. Completion of general education courses taken at NWFSC with a grade of "C" or higher. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 20 or more credits: 5 points• 15-19 credits: 4 points• 10-14 credits: 3 points• 5-9 credits: 2 points• 1-4 credits: 1 point	/5
b. Current resident of Okaloosa or Walton County by June 1. (10 Points)	/10
C Military Service with honorable discharge. (5 points) Proof of military service via DD Form 22, 22a, 256, 214 or 215 Additional 5 points for medical MOS or AFS	/10
d. Current American Heart Association BLS provider certification.	/10
e. Current employment with an Okaloosa or Walton County public safety (Beach Safety, Fire Department/District) agency** (10 points)	/10
f. A current additional Health Certification e.g. RN, CNA, CMA, ECA, , Pharmacy Tech., etc. (5 points)	/5
Total Score	/50

The students with the highest point totals are selected first. If there is a tie among point totals prior to reaching program capacity, a random lottery among the tied students will determine who is selected.
