## NORTHWEST FLORIDA STATE COLLEGE AVIATION AIRFRAME MECHANICS ADMISSION POINT SYSTEM

Applicants for the Aviation Airframe Mechanics program must meet the following mandatory requirements to be evaluated for admission. The selection process will be based upon the admission criteria point system. Applicants with the highest total number of points based on the information contained in their application file will be finalists for the program beginning in the fall semester. Applicants meeting the criteria, but not selected, will be placed on an alternate list. Individuals on the alternate list may be selected if slots become available before the end of the Drop/Add period for the fall semester. Students not selected by the end of Drop/Add, must reapply during the next application period for the following year.
