The Fall 2022 PTA Technical Program Cohort Selection Cycle is now open! Please note that to be eligible to apply for the PTA Technical Program Cohort, you must meet the following minimum requirements:

- A grade of "C" or higher in all pre-requisite courses
 - <u>Note</u>: Pre-requisite courses for the <u>2021-22 catalog</u> include ENC 1101, BSC 1085C, MGF 1106 or higher, HSC 1531 and PHI 2600).
 - <u>Note:</u> Pre-requisite courses for the <u>2022-23 catalog</u> include ENC 1101, BSC 1085C, Core Math, Core Humanity, and Civic Literacy course (AMH 2020 or POS 1041).
 - Students currently enrolled in these courses at the time of the PTA Technical Program Cohort selection review may be granted conditional acceptance pending confirmation of meeting the requirements.
- A Cumulative GPA of 2.50 in all pre-requisite courses

If you have met all the above requirements (or will have them met by the end of the Fall 2022 term and are ready to be considered for the PTA Technical Program Cohort, please complete the PTA Technical Program Cohort application at the link below.
