NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD SINGLE SOURCE

Northwest Florida State College, in accordance with Florida Statutes 287.057(3), is providing public Notice of the Intent to Award Single Source to KONE Inc., the installation of elevator door lock monitoring devices as required by ASME Elevator Safety Code A17.3-2015, Safety Code for Existing Elevators and Escalators which includes Section 3.10 Operating Devices and Control Equipment, Requirement 3.10.12 System to Monitor and Prevent Automatic Operation of the Elevator with Faulty Door Contact Circuits to be in compliance of the Code by December 31, 2023. KONE Inc. is the College's current maintenance contractor per service agreement effective July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2025.

Any vendor who does not agree that the service(s) are available only from the contractor determined to be a single source may protest the "Notice of Intent to Award" by contracting the Purchasing Department within seven (7) days of the date of Notice is posted.

PROTEST: All protests shall be filed in accordance with Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, and the NWFSC purchasing policies. Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed in Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes. Protestors are required to post a bond equal to 5% of the accepted bid per Florida Statute 255.0516. NWFSC will follow the statutory procedures for the resolution of protests arising from the contracting process. It is the Sole responsibility of the protestor to know and follow all procedures according to Florida Statutes.

The Bureau of Elevator Safety has adopted new ASME Elevator Safety Code A17.3-2015, Safety Code for Existing Elevators and Escalators. Part of this new Safety Code includes Section 3.10 Operating Devices and Control Equipment, Requirement 3.10.12 System to Monitor and Prevent Automatic Operation of the Elevator with Faulty Door Contact Circuits. All conveyances licensed by the State of Florida Bureau of Elevator Safety, including those located within the 5 contracted jurisdictions must be in compliance of the above Code by December 31, 2023. The Bureau of Elevator Safety encourages all owners of conveyances licensed by the State of Florida or any of its 5 Contracted Jurisdictions to contact your Elevator Company to discuss what your conveyances will need in order to comply with this section of A17.3-2015.
