APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is complete when the following items are on file in the Fine & Performing Arts Division office:

- 1. **Completed, scholarship application form.** Please neatly fill this form out in blue or black ink. You may type the form.
- 2. Verification of applicant's cumulative GPA (Guidance Counselor's form). If you have completed a semester or more of college outside of high school, please leave page 3 blank.
- 3. Letters of recommendation. "Letter of Recommendation" forms are attached to facilitate this process.
- 4. Participate in the vocal audition. This audition will consist of three parts.
 - i. <u>Solo Vocals</u>: Vocalists should prepare two (2) contrasting pieces from memory. One may be in a foreign language but is not required. You may also choose two contrasting pieces from appropriate classical repertoire, musical theatre repertoire, standard jazz repertoire, or contemporary pop/R&B repertoire. You may use musical accompaniment on your phone and an AUX cable will be provided to play from our system. If you wish to have piano accompaniment, please turn in sheet music with your application.
 - ii. <u>Music Theory Placement Test:</u> A two-page written theory test to assess what level of Music Theory courses to place you in. *This will not affect your chances of receiving a scholarship. This is only required for students intending to take Music Theory in the Fall or Spring.*
 - iii. <u>Group Vocals:</u> Vocalists may be asked to participate in a group callback to hear vocalists perform in a group setting. This will allow for directors to test blending, vocal placements, and learning capabilities. *Vocalists do not need to prepare anything for this portion of the audition.*
 - iv. <u>Audition Date:</u> In-person audition dates, April 27, 2024, at 9 am in the Tyler Recital Hall or May 18, 2024, at 9 am in the Sprint Theatre. You can schedule a private audition with Professor Skylar Smith if you are unable to make it to one of the audition days until June 30, 2024, for the Fall 2024 school year.

EVALUATION SCHEDULE

Failure to submit your paperwork by the dates listed below may result in not being considered for scholarship awards. Scholarship amounts vary on ensemble placement. All students selected for Voices of Northwest Florida receive a \$4,000 annual scholarship to cover Fall and Spring tuition.

Application Deadline: Friday, June 28, 2024, at 4:00 PM. All application materials must be received by the Fine Arts Division office by this date.
