Plan for Treatment in a Medical Emergency

Statement of Understanding

For all illnesses/accidents that are not serious medical emergencies or life threatening, the parents will be notified and they will come to the CDEC to pick up their child.

I understand that the following procedures will be followed in the event that my child has a serious medical emergency while in attendance at the Child Development & Education Center:

- First Aid and/or CPR procedures will begin immediately.
- The emergency number, 911, will be dialed and immediate medical assistance will be requested.
- Once the child is under the care of the emergency medical team, sooner when possible, the parents will be called.
- In the event that the parents cannot be reached, the family doctor listed on the enrollment form will be contacted. Then the other emergency contacts on the enrollment form will be contacted in that order. The CDEC will continue to attempt to contact the guardian.
- The emergency medical team will determine which hospital to transport the child, but in serious medical emergencies the patient is normally transported to the nearest medical emergency facility.
- A CDEC staff member will go to the hospital and await the parents.
