Application Process

The application process is complete when the following items are on file in the Fine & Performing Arts Division office:

- 1. **Completed, scholarship application form.** Please neatly fill this form out in blue or black ink. You may type the form.
- 2. **Verification of applicant's cumulative GPA (Guidance Counselor's form).** If you have completed a semester or more of college outside of high school, please leave page 3 blank.
- 3. **Letters of recommendation.** "Letter of Recommendation" forms are attached to facilitate this process.
- 4. **Photograph of applicant.** (Preferably wallet sized) Please attach to your scholarship application with a paperclip; do not staple, tape, or glue. Print our name on the bottom back edge of the photo.
- 5. Participate in the dance clinic. The clinic will be held Thursday, April 25, 2024
- 6. Participate in an audition. The audition will be held Friday, April 26, 2024.

Evaluation Schedule

Failure to submit your paperwork by the dates listed below may result in not being considered for scholarship awards.

<u>Application Deadline:</u> Thursday, April 25, 2024, by 11:59 p.m. (CT). All application materials must be received by the Fine Arts Division office.

<u>Clinic Date:</u> Thursday, April 25, 2024 (6 p.m. – 8 p.m.) in the NWFSC Dance Studio Room Building 100 Room 125. Candidates will focus on dance techniques, basic acrobatic skills, and learn the audition dance combination. Attire: all black, with appropriate dance shoes (split sole or jazz shoes).

<u>Audition Date:</u> Friday, April 26, 2024 (6 p.m. – 8 p.m.) in the NWFSC Dance Studio Room Building 100 Room 125. The audition will assess skills learned during the clinic, including jazz dance progressions, basic acrobatic skills, and the dance combination.

**IMPORTANT: If unable to attend the clinic and/or audition, candidates may request permission to submit a video audition due Thursday, April 25, 2024, by 11:59 p.m. For further video audition requirements, contact Vanessa Kanamoto, Assistant Professor of Dance, at kanamotv@nwfsc.edu.
